This was a headline on the Fox News website this past Monday morning. Of course, it caught my eye.

Satanic after-school club takes aim at Christian student groups

I read the article to make sure I understood the headline. The first paragraph of the article states: *"The Satanic Temple recently opened an after-school "Satan Club" in a Moline, Illinois, elementary school, as part of its nationwide campaign to push back against the Christian Good News Clubs offered to schoolchildren after regular-hour classes."*

Now, I will say, that a leader in The Satanic Temple in Moline is leading the "Satan Club" himself and states, "We're not including items of religious opinion ... We're not teaching children about Satanism. They're just going to know that this is taught by Satanists." Greaves continued: "The after-school Satan Clubs were conceived of in order to give an alternative to [the] religious indoctrination [of] after-school programs."

The Satanic Temple says it's really an atheist organization, despite a statue depicting its leader as a tall human with a goat's head and horns and two children looking on adoringly.

The article's author goes on to state: *The Satanic Temple is not hiding the fact that it created the clubs to take on the Christian club called the Good News Club — which has become its No. 1 nemesis.* Reece Kauffman, president of Child Evangelism, which operates the Good News Clubs, said of the Satanic Temple, "I cannot tell you what's in their hearts, but they certainly are doing work that would *be contrary to the Good News of Jesus Christ.*"

In June of 2001 The U.S. Supreme Court ruled that religious groups could operate after-class programs in public schools of which "The Satan Clubs" are considered such.

As you might imagine, there has been some push back by some parents and they have had some protests at the school on the days that the Satan Club meets.

Am I surprised at this happening? NO, not in the least. The attack and down right persecution of Christianity and the Bible is coming more swiftly and is more blatant everyday. What is amazing to me is that these who want to combat Christianity in America use the law for their purpose, and fight against the same law, for their purpose. Here is what I mean by that. They use "Freedom of Religion" to say: "We have a right to practice our 'religion' too." But then when a Christian church places a manger scene outside of a downtown church building at Christmas time, the same groups says: "This violates our rights for having to see this Christian scene in a public space (even though it is on church property) and that the church shouldn't be able to claim 'Freedom of Religion' to show publicly a scene depicting Christ's birth."
