"Where Is Your Identity Found?"

Christine was beautiful and she knew it, played it, used it to get what she wanted. Many of the other girls in high school looked down on her, even made fun of her and jokes about her. The guys, on the other hand, enjoyed the attention Christine gave them and her openness to have sex with any of them.

The back story on Christine. She was brought up in a home with her mom and stepdad. Her stepdad had an older son from a previous marriage that lived in the home. You probably already know where the story goes. This step-brother sexually abuse Christine as she was younger. She now felt her worth, her identity, was only found in sex. Because of that openness and her beauty, she could garner attention from just about any male, not just high school boys.

But something happened to change that. God was at work in two people's lives, though they did not know it. A new kid came to their high school his senior year. Josh was a nice looking, tall, well built young man and, of course, this was a challenge to Christine to "get him" before any of the other girls had a chance. He had noticed her in one of his classes and as she began to talk to him at his locker between classes, they decided they would get supper together on Friday night before the football game. Christine made her move as they got back in the car after supper, but Josh was different. He pushed her away, to her surprise. That had never ever happened before to her. Everyone had been receptive to her advances.

To make a long story shorter, Josh befriended Christine. He shared with her that Jesus was his source of identity and that everything ran through his relationship with Jesus as his Lord. She had never been exposed to anyone like Josh, much less someone who loved and shared Jesus. Her life began to change. God used Josh to bring Christine to HIM. And as the Holy Spirit began to work in her, calling her to Himself, the walls began to breakdown. The heartache, lack of self-worth began to change. And without pushing, one night she asked Josh how she could have what he had in Jesus.

Folks, we talk about how the Holy Spirit will move in a persons life in church. We talk about how God will use us, as Believers, to share this Good News of Jesus, but I'm not sure that that belief always leaves the church with us. I read a few verses in my sermon this past Sunday from Colossians chapter 3. Chapter 3 is a reminder of where our identity is found and how we are to live and share love in unity as we live in this dark world. PLEASE read these 17 verses slowly and take in all the Apostle Paul is writing as inspired by the Holy Spirit.

Colossians 3:1 - 17

Therefore if you have been raised up with Christ, keep seeking the things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God. 2 Set your mind on the things above, not on the things that are on earth. 3 For you have died and your life is hidden with Christ in God. 4 When Christ, who is our life, is revealed, then you also will be revealed with Him in glory.

5 Therefore consider the members of your earthly body as dead to immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and greed, which amounts to

idolatry. 6 For it is because of these things that the wrath of God will come upon the sons of disobedience, 7 and in them you also once walked, when you were living in them. 8 But now you also, put them all aside: anger, wrath, malice, slander, and abusive speech from your mouth. 9 Do not lie to one another, since you laid aside the old self with its evil practices, 10 and have put on the new self who is being renewed to a true knowledge according to the image of the One who created him— 11 a renewal in which there is no distinction between Greek and Jew, circumcised and uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave and freeman, but Christ is all, and in all.

12 So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience;
13 bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you.
14 Beyond all these things put on love, which is the perfect bond of unity.
15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; and be thankful. 16 Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God. 17 Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father.

WOW!!! So much here. Several sermons and teachings! The call to us all, as Believers, is to do as a young man named Josh had done, surrender ourselves to Jesus and make sure our identity is found in Jesus and no one or nothing else. If our identity is found in ourselves, in others, in sex, or our beauty or anything else, we need to stop and check ourselves. God's call is to surrender ALL to Him.

Was it easy for Christine? No! But the new immature Christian began to grow and began to read God's Word and began to surround herself with people like Josh and her life in Jesus began to grow and flourish. She became solid in her faith and she found her identity in Jesus and no one or nothing else.

Where is your identity found? In your children? In your spouse? In your work? In yourself? Or is your identity found in Jesus? There is a huge difference in how you answer that question.

I'll leave it there for now. Thank you Jesus for working in Josh and Christine's lives. Thank you Jesus for working in ours. May the Lord be praised
