"Caution, Danger Ahead!"

Last Friday, Terry and I drove down to South Carolina to meet with a new church plant and their pastor in St. George. We walked the city and prayed over it and for the new church. Later that afternoon we drove to Charleston and spent the night before coming home Saturday. I booked a room in the same hotel that we spent our honeymoon in years ago. This was Terry's first trip back since then.

The France Marion Hotel, named for Revolutionary War hero Francis Marion (the "Swamp Fox"), became an instant Charleston landmark when it opened in 1924. Rising 12 stories above the Historic District, the hotel offers spectacular views of Charleston's church steeples, historic mansions, and famous harbor, providing easy access to the wealth of Charleston's attractions.

Friday night, after eating in the Swamp Fox Restaurant, we walked about 3 and half miles around in the Historic District. As we were walking back towards the hotel, we were crossing a side street when I stepped on the side of a pot hole in the street and fell. Of course, there had to be a car coming down the street and 100's of people around. One guys said, as I was laying in the road, "Hey, you okay?" To which I replied, "Not really". I busted my elbow, knee, twisted my ankle, and jammed by shoulder trying to keep from face planting into the asphalt. I've been quite sore ever since.

As we all know, asphalt is black. And Friday night on the streets of Charleston it was dark in many areas where the streets lights didn't cover. So I never saw the pot hole as I was walking across the street which caused me to fall. Because I have vertigo, I try to be careful with my steps and sudden moves, but if you can't see or are unaware what is ahead, there can linger danger.

2 Corinthians 11:26 "I have been on frequent journeys, in dangers from rivers, dangers from robbers, dangers from my countrymen, dangers from the Gentiles, dangers in the city, dangers in the wilderness, dangers on the sea, dangers among false brethren..."

Jesus, Paul, Peter, James, John, Luke, Matthew and Mark, all tell us as we read the New Testament, that there is danger ahead. We are told to watch, be aware of what lies ahead, to use caution. But like my incident, sometimes you cannot see it. It is hidden from you. It is then you have to rely on your teaching from God's word. Remember what Jesus did when tempted? He used His Father's word. Folks, you need to know, memorize it. Have it on your mind so that when the dangers come, and they will, unexpectedly, you are ready.

Thankfully, my wife was by my side, aiding me to my feet. Caring for me out of love. When the unexpected happens, that is when our loved ones come to our aid. What a blessing.
