### "What Has Happened to Our Society?"

Ephesians 4:15 "...speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in all aspects into Him who is the head, even Christ..."

What has happened to our society? What will this path we are going down lead us to?

Just in my lifetime, we go back to the 50's and hear, "Oh, those rebel raising teenagers and their rock and roll music are going to bring Jesus back. It's Satan music. And the moving of those hips is just sinful."

In the 60's we had the hippy movement and war protests. The LSD and drug scene exploded and the church was sending every teenager to hell.

In the 70's we decided as a society it was okay to kill babies in the womb. Society called it a "woman's right to her body" never considering the life that was being killed, ignoring the right of the baby to live. At that point the value of life itself began to be degraded and fast forward to today and a baby born alive at 40 weeks, but intended to be aborted, can lay there and died in the name of a "right". Where have we gone wrong here?

The 80's and 90's brought movement after movement. AIDS and the "Gay Revolution" gained prominence. That, of course, only escalated in the 2000's.

Today, "everything" is offensive. You can't speak about anything without someone taking issue and wanting you shut down, ostracized, or demonized. There is very little debate that actually happens any longer. Instead, it is about attacking the opinions of another. The "truth" doesn't matter in our society. If bending the truth or ignoring the truth provides traction for your own agenda, so be it. I've heard more than one talking head say that, "It's worth the false narrative to move forward with your agenda." How sad!

So I asked, "What has happened to our society?" Of course the answer goes back to the fall. No non-believer understands this. No one following their own idols of self and pride understands this. But this is the

truth and only the truth. At the fall of mankind, we replaced God with the idols of "self". Remember, "If you eat of this fruit you will be like God." And every culture since, has bought into the lie.

Paul states that we are to "speak truth in love." One of the things that I believe has happened is that the church has failed to do that. Hear me folks, we are to NEVER be swayed from the truths of scripture and the moral standards that God has given us to live by. NEVER. But how we relay that message is so important.

I don't know at this point with the path we are currently on in societies around the world, that we will turn the ship. And His reminder to me is that anytime I don't remember to place Him first in my thoughts, actions, and deeds, I too am running the risk of idol worship, that being "me."

Believers, Church, stand firm on the truth, but share truth in love. Paul finishes this verse by saying, "we are to grow up in ALL aspects into Him who is the head, even Christ..." May we do just that.
