"Believers, You Are Not to be Like the Hypocrites"

Hypocrite (Definition): **1)** a person who pretends to have virtues, moral or religious beliefs, principles, etc., that they do not actually possess, especially a person whose actions belie stated beliefs. **2)** a person who feigns some desirable or publicly approved attitude, especially one whose private life, opinions, or statements belie their public statements. (*from dictionary.com*)

Terry, Emma, and I, when we can, watch the two music talent shows on television, *The Voice* and *American Idol*. We have watched for years because the three of us love music and enjoy the shows. We get to see talent from across America, and in some cases from around the world, come on stage and perform songs that we have heard from the original artist. Sometimes it's great, others are good, and then there are those who are "not so good".

The celebrity judges on both shows attempt to coach these contestants to make them better. Of course, some of the suggestions and criticism is for "show purposes", we know that, but as the numbers are whittled down to the final eight or ten, there is something that almost always happens.

On both shows the judges/coaches tell the remaining singers to "be true to who you are". Over and over they remind these singers that people know if they are a fake and are trying to be something they are not. Sometimes a singer will pick a song and after preforming it will say, "I wanted to show a different side of me and my voice." Invariably one of the judges or coaches will say, "...but that is not who you are." Or in other words, you were not true to yourself. It is really hard for a country singer to sing a Rap or even a hard rock song. It just doesn't sound genuine.

This past Sunday and Monday night, *American Idol* and *The Voice* were on and as the judges and coaches were saying to the singers again, "Don't try to be something you're not," I thought about The Sermon on the Mount that we are preaching through at HOPE Church. In chapter six in this sermon, Jesus says, "Do not be like the hypocrites who..." three different times.

Matthew 6:2

"So when you give to the poor, do not sound a trumpet before you, as the **hypocrites** do in the synagogues and in the streets, so that they may be honored by men. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full."

Matthew 6:5

"When you pray, you are not to be like the **hypocrites**; for they love to stand and pray in the synagogues and on the street corners so that they may be seen by men. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full."

Matthew 6:16

"Whenever you fast, do not put on a gloomy face as the **hypocrites** do, for they neglect their appearance so that they will be noticed by men when they are fasting. Truly I say to you, they have their reward in full."

In Matthew 23, Jesus gives the eight "woes" and states seven times: "But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, **hypocrites**, because..." (my bold in all cases of hypocrites)

If Jesus warns us, not to be hypocrites, pretending to be something we are not, why wouldn't we heed His warning? As believers in Jesus Christ, we are given in His Word the characteristics that we are to have as Christians, followers of Jesus. When we are around others outside of our church family, when we are with family, friends, neighbors, or coworkers, we are to act and display the righteous character we are called to by Jesus. If we belie beliefs of who we are in Christ Jesus, then we are hypocrites.

Jesus, in Matthew 24, talks about the "end times and His return" and speaks of those who are doing evil, doing the things they know they shouldn't do and that He will send them away with the hypocrites. Or in other words, they were pretending to know Him, but really didn't.

Matthew 7:22-23:" Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in Your name, and in Your name cast out demons, and in Your name perform many miracles?' And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness."

Living as a hypocrite will gain you nothing. Let us all be true to whose we are and live out the righteousness we are called to by Jesus Christ and His Word. May it be so!

And as a side note, for those of you whose watch *American Idol* and *The Voice*, I'll go on record saying, Iam will win *American Idol* and Gina will win *The Voice*.
