"Stay Vigilant in the Faith"

I grew up in the 60's and 70's and I'm sure many of you reading this article can identify with what I'm about to say. Kindergarten through fifth grade we said the Pledge of Allegiance and prayed at the start of our day each week. It was not unusual for my teachers to have scripture posters on the walls in my classroom. I had one teacher, when we became a little more rambunctious than she thought we ought to be, would stop class and have us stand and she would say a prayer over us.

In Columbus County, NC elementary school was K - 8 grades and High School was 9 -12 grades. At Guideway Elementary School, once a week we would gather for assembly in the auditorium, of course by grades, youngest at the front, oldest towards the back. And at the start of every assembly either our Principle or one of the teachers would open with a scripture reading, an application of the scripture for us, and a prayer.

I cannot be sure it didn't happen, but I never heard of or saw any student or any parent complain about these procedures. In fact, my parents said, once this was stopped; "What harm does it do to pray and read the Bible". And yes, when I entered sixth grade, the first day of class was quite different than my first 6 years of school. No pledge! No prayer!

I remember in my home church the adults talking about taking prayer out of public schools and the fact they thought it was wrong. Our pastor said from the pulpit that this was only the beginning.

As I have grown up over the years, Pastor Wall's statement has continued to bear truth. Our American culture has gradually taken away the rights of Christians to practice their faith publicly. There are those who say, "The nativity scene in Town Square offends me." Others, "The cross is a symbol of violence, take it down." The cross offends me, remove it." "Please remove the Ten Commandments. They offend me." Christianity, has been and still is, slowly being marginalized in our society. Even Christians have been programmed to keep quiet, don't say anything about your faith, no Bibles in the work place, etc, in order to keep their jobs. And, this is my opinion, the slope we have traveled down in my lifetime has been a slippery slope to a chaotic society, with very little discipline or accountability. "Self" rules the day, but does so in a hypocritical way. Let me explain.

A Utah school district has banned the Bible from their elementary and middle schools. Here is a clip from the article.

1 Timothy 6:3-5; 11-12a "If anyone advocates a different doctrine and does not agree with sound words, those of our Lord Jesus Christ, and with the doctrine conforming to godliness, 4 he is conceited and understands nothing; but he has a morbid interest in controversial questions and disputes about words, out of which arise envy, strife, abusive language, evil suspicions, 5 and constant friction between men of depraved mind and deprived of the truth, who suppose that godliness is a means of gain. 11 But flee from these things, you man of God, and pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, perseverance and gentleness. 12 Fight the good fight of faith..."

We win the battle and have eternal peace to look forward to, but in the meantime, in the midst of all going on around us, we must stay vigilant in the faith. Do not be swayed by false prophets or the tickling of the ears with sweet words.
