"BE BOLD!"

Matthew 5:14 - 16: "You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden; nor does anyone light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on the lamp-stand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father who is in heaven.

As many of you know, we were on vacation last week in the Great Smokey Mountains of Tennessee, specifically, Pigeon Forge. On Tuesday evening, after supper, we stopped by a Veteran's Store I had seen on the strip. I was looking for a specific hat. I doubt many know, but I'm a hat collector. I probably have 40 or 50 hats and when traveling, I look for hats. Anyway, I found a unique hat that I had not seen before.

When I was in the USAF I served at a Military Airlift Command base. The Air Force has other specific designated bases, but after graduating from the Security Police Academy, I was stationed at a MAC base. I had never seen a MAC specific hat, so of course I bought it. With my military discount, I paid \$22 and some change for the hat.



The next day, Wednesday, I wore the hat as we went to Dollywood to spend the day. Before I got inside the park, two different people thanked me for my service. During the day I received a discount for some merchandise we bought because of being "military". We left the park and went to supper at a restaurant and I was thanked for my service and received a military discount when checking out. The next day I wore the hat and the same thing happened. On Friday I wore the hat the same thing happened all day. By Friday night following supper I was adding up the discounts I had received for those three days and I was up to \$30 worth of savings, more than the cost of the hat. By the way, I didn't initialize any of the discounts, but was told by someone working at each business I was illegible because of my military service as they noticed my hat.

On Saturday we went to the Bible Museum located in Pigeon Forge. If you are visiting that area, I would highly recommend

you spend some time and take the guided tour. After completing the tour, we went into the Bible Book Store that is attached and on the counter were several hats. One caught my eye and I purchased it. On the front it reads "Christ is King". On the bill of the hat "I Love Jesus" and on the back of the hat "I Love Jesus". I wore that the rest of the day and to supper that night. No one had anything to say to me. No, "I love your hat", or "So glad you love Jesus", or "Christ is my King too". No, "I'm so glad you belong to Jesus" or "So glad you are saved".



This got me thinking. We are quick to acknowledge someone who served in the military, thanking them, giving discounts, etc., but no acknowledgment for who I serve. No acknowledgment of where my final destination is, or my love of Jesus. Nothing.

Now to be honest, I really didn't expect anyone to say anything, but as I thought more about it, why not? Shouldn't I say something to someone who is sporting a shirt or T-shirt with something to do with "Christianity"? Can't I say, "Hey, love your shirt" or "Hey, so glad your are a follow of Jesus" or maybe "Hey, we are heading to the same place"! Doesn't Jesus say in the Sermon on the Mount to "Let your light shine before men"? Letting it shine could be wearing clothing, but also could be acknowledging someone else. We aren't supposed to hide our light, which means BE BOLD!

You will see me wearing my "Christ Is King" hat from time to time and I've decided if I see someone else acknowledging their faith in Christ, I'm going to say something to them. BE BOLD my friends. Jesus is counting on us to spread the Gospel. Today is a great day to do just that.
