"The Desire to Obey"

Deuteronomy 5:16 "Honor your father and your mother, as the Lord your God has commanded you, that your days may be prolonged and that it may go well with you on the land which the Lord your God gives you."

I had a great childhood. I loved my mom and dad and my sister. I had a great extended family that lived close around me. I had close friends that lived near by. I could hunt and fish. I could swim in the three ponds on the farm anytime. I rode horses/ponies, played with the cows and pigs (I really did). I learned how to farm the crops we grew. Yes, hard work, but I didn't know any better. It was what you did when you lived and grew up in a rural farming community. We didn't have a lot, but we lack for nothing.

As I many of you know my mom died when I was 15 years old. That was in February of 1973. In April of that year I gave my life to the Lord. He became my Lord, my Savior and my life changed.

Yes, I loved my parents in those growing years, but my obedience was more related to not wishing to be punished than it was because of my love for them. They set the rules and if I obeyed, I was not punished. But if I failed to obey, punishment came my way. It is one of the ways we teach our children right from wrong.

But after I gave my life to the Lord, things changed. I obeyed because it was the right thing to do. It wasn't to avoid punishment, it was because I saw that disobedience was a sin. My Lord said I was to honor, love, and obey my parents and I tried my best to live into that daily. I didn't make it every day, but most days I did.

Likewise, my love of my heavenly Father causes me to have the inward desire to obey Him. To do what is right by His standards, His commands, His Holy Word. I do not want to disappointment my heavenly Father because I love Him. My desire is to keep my focus on Him and not me. My desire is to obey out of love.

John 8:42 "Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and have come from God, for I have not even come on My own initiative, but He sent Me."

John 16:27 "...for the Father Himself loves you, because you have loved Me and have believed that I came forth from the Father."

1 John 2:15 "Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him."

The Lord wants us to love Him enough to obey without hesitation. There should be no hesitation to love and serve Him. We have to frequently ask ourselves, "Is there any area of my life currently out of alignment with God's Word?" We have to be willing to deal with it, ask God His for forgiveness and to give us, by the power of His Spirit, the willingness to change. That leads to contentment and peace. It does not mean that everything is great or all the things around us are going right or perfect. It simply means our love of the Father, our desire to obey Him and to live a righteous life, satisfies our soul. Our life, lived in obedience to God, is filled with peace that passes understanding. I love Him because He first loved me.

Are we following a set of rules or living in obedience because of our love of our Father? Praise Him today for the joy that comes from living for Him in obedience.
