"The Sovereignty of God"

There is a story recorded in English history about one of their warships. Sovereign of the Seas, a seventeenth-century British warship, was ordered to be built by King Charles the First in 1634 and it launched in 1637. The Sovereign of the Seas was the most beautiful ship, at that time, in the British navy. She was also the most powerful, boasting 102 cannons. The goal for Sovereign warship was to manifest her name: to rule the oceans. She did that until 1696 when she caught fire and burned down to the waterline. The Sovereign of the Seas was no more, and also, no longer sovereign.

God has told us over and over in His Word that He is always and forever Sovereign. Just a couple of verses to indicate that:

"The Lord has established His throne in heaven, and His kingdom rules over all." Psalm 103:19

"Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed" (Daniel 7:14).

The Sovereign of the Seas warship of England's dominion only lasted a few years and it was over. We have seen earthly Kings, Pharaohs, Emperors and even Presidents serve, only to die and relinquish their power and sovereignty over the people. And temporary or partial sovereignty is not really sovereignty at all. One is either sovereign or not.

When the Bible speaks of God's sovereignty, it makes clear that He is sovereign over all. God's sovereignty is complete and never-ending.

Do we believe this? I look at the 21st Century church and wonder if we truly believe in the sovereignty of God. As a believer in Jesus, saved, sanctified, headed toward eternal life with Him, do we believe that Father/Son/Holy Spirit is in control of all things? Is our faith such, that when the Bible tells us not to worry, don't be anxious, that we can really turn those things over to our sovereign God? I'm not sure.

I hear Christians express their worry about many things, both personally and church related. What is going to happen

Satan loves for us to worry. Satan loves for us to be consumed by worry and wonder if God is listening to us, if

He hears our plea. Satan wants to distract you from the understanding that God is sovereign and that He will never leave you or forsake you. (Hebrews 13:5)

We are in the middle of our Revitalization plan for HOPE Church Raleigh. We have just begun the 50-Days to Vitality. Some may wonder if God is in this? Can God work with us through this? And the answers are yes and yes. God is sovereign and works His wonders through His people for His church. It is a wonderful plan and works well when we respond to Him.

Can God bring revitalization to HOPE? Absolutely. Can God bring growth, both spiritually and numerically to HOPE? Absolutely. But He wants to use us, our gifts, our talents, our positions, our relationships to do it.

We worry about the church we love. What is next? What if this happens or doesn't happen? I've heard it now for months. So do we believe God is sovereign? If so, are we living into His sovereignty?

Church, never let the troubles of this world, or your life, or the church, cause you to worry. God has got this. Please know that God is going to use you and me, and in fact others, to move HOPE Church into His future will and purpose. It is not, sit back and do nothing, but be engaged and usable by God. Put your faith in the One who has all authority in heaven and on earth. "And Jesus came up and spoke to them, saying, 'All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth." Matthew 28:18

R. C. Sproul once said, "If God is not sovereign, then God is not God."

The Sovereign of the Seas warship may have burned in 1696 and no longer was sovereign over the waters, but I can tell you, God is still sovereign and working in wonderful ways beyond our comprehension to fulfill all He has planned for His church and the future. Thank you Jesus.
