"There Is Power In Prayer!"

The Greek writer, Homer, tells us that when Ulysses came to the Aegean isle where the daughter of the sun, Circe, lived he climbed a hill and saw in the center of the island a palace surrounded with trees. He sent one half of his crew, under the command of Eurylochus, as a vanguard, to see if he could find hospitality. When the men approached the palace, which was surrounded by wild animals that had once been men now changed into beasts by Circe's witchcraft, they heard the sounds of soft music from within. When they entered - all but their leader Eurylochus, who suspected danger - Circe served them with wine and other delicacies. When they had eaten and drunk heartily she touched them one by one with her wand, and they were immediately changed into swine.

When Eurylochus brought the news of this disaster to Ulysses, he went to rescue his men. As he was going to the palace, he was met on the way by Mercury, who warned him of the dangerous arts of Circe. But as Ulysses would not be swayed from his desire to save his men, Mercury put in his hand a flower, the fragrance of which he was to inhale, which possessed the power to resist all sorceries of Circe. Armed with this flower, Ulysses entered the palace of Circe, who entertained him as she had his companions; and when he had eaten and drunk, she touched him with her wand, saying, "Here, seek the sty and wallow with they friends!" But protected from her spell by the flower which he carried, Ulysses drew his sword and demanded her to release his companions and restore them to their human form.

As believers in Jesus Christ, we should have a desire to live morally and have a desire to raise the standards of justice, truth, and righteousness to the level of God's expectation of His children and of His Word so that we can stave off the sorcery of our modern world. We may not be faced with Circe's witchcraft, but Satan and his demons, his followers, are at every corner tempting and pulling at us to fail in our relationship with Jesus.

Our strength as Believers is not found in a flower, but in the strength of the Almighty God and who has given us the medium of prayer to communicate directly with Him. Are you communicating with Him in prayer?

One of the finest examples of the effectiveness of prayer was given by Jesus Christ, when just before His betrayal, He prayed in the Garden of Gethsemene. We read: "And He withdrew from them (the disciples) about a stone's throw, and knelt down and prayed... And there appeared to Him an angel from heaven, strengthening Him." Luke 22:41, 43 Jesus was so encouraged He continued to the cross and overcame all human threats and obstacles and Satan's ploy's. He was faithful to His Father in carrying out His plan of redemption for us. Thank you Jesus!

Folks, we have the same opportunity to have power to overcome our human weaknesses and the temptations of this world. It is not the flower of Mercury that will give us power to overcome, but the powerful presence of HIs Spirit, the powerful word of prayer, and the powerful words in His Word. All of this is available to us as Believers, as Jesus Christ has provided them for us.
