"PENTECOST"

The Birth of the Church – Acts 1–2

- 1. Jesus' Final Instructions (Acts 1:1–11)
- Jesus appeared to His disciples for 40 days after His resurrection, teaching them about the **Kingdom of God** (v. 3).
- He told them to **wait in Jerusalem** for the gift of the Holy Spirit (v. 4–5).
- Promise: "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses..." (v. 8)
- Jesus **ascended into heaven**, and angels promised He would return (v. 9–11).

> 2. Preparing for the Spirit (Acts 1:12–26)

- The disciples returned to **Jerusalem** and met in the **upper room** (v. 13).
- They were **united in prayer** with other believers, including Mary and Jesus' brothers (v. 14).
- **Matthias** was chosen to replace Judas, restoring the group of 12 apostles (v. 26).

♦ 3. The Holy Spirit Arrives (Acts 2:1–13)

- On Pentecost, the Holy Spirit came with a sound like wind and tongues of fire resting on each of them (v. 1–3).
- The believers spoke in **other languages**, and people from every nation heard the Gospel in their own tongues (v. 4–11).
- Some were amazed, while others mocked, thinking the disciples were drunk (v. 12–13).

4. Peter's Bold Sermon (Acts 2:14–41)

- Peter explained this fulfilled Joel's prophecy: "I will pour out My Spirit on all flesh..." (v. 17).
- He proclaimed that **Jesus is both Lord and Christ**, crucified and raised by God (v. 36).
- The crowd was convicted and asked, "What shall we do?"
 - Peter answered:
 - "Repent and be baptized... and you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." (v. 38)
 - About 3,000 people were baptized that day (v. 41).

• 5. The Early Church is Born (Acts 2:42–47)

The new believers:

- ✓ Continued in **apostles' teaching**
- ✓ Practiced fellowship and sharing
- ✓ Broke bread and **prayed together**

✓ Worshiped daily and lived in **unity and joy** "And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved." (v. 47)

📌 Key Takeaway for Today

The Church was born in unity, prayer, and power through the Holy Spirit. It began with a bold witness of the risen Jesus and continues today through the same Spirit. **Are we living with that same power and purpose?**
